CONCEPT

Angloville is a unique experience that enables linguistic and cultural exchange between native English speakers and language students, most of whom are successful professionals or ambitious youths; depending on the programme you attend. As English speakers, our participants stay in our beautiful venues in Central Europe, Malta and the UK for 1-8 weeks and help local students improve their English through a series of conversations and activities. During each programme, their stay with full board is covered and an unforgettable cultural exchange experience is quaranteed.

HISTORY

In 2011, our two co-founders (Michal Zak and Michal Kelles-Krauz, who are school friends, came to the conclusion that the present English teaching methodology was not efficient for language students. Books and classrooms don't offer what an intensive stay in an Englishspeaking country does. Both of them learnt English this way. In the meantime, many of their university friends in the UK, where they studied, asked them about visiting Poland and travelling in Central Europe. They would love to experience a cultural immersion. They saw a great match there so they researched the language immersion methodology and this is how Angloville was born - by bringing these two worlds together.

WHO ARE WE?

We are a team of 50 young internationals, all passionate about English language and culture, cultural experiences and travelling. We have a wide range of positions and roles: Programme coordinators, pedagogists, health and safety specialists, recruiters, trainers, sales representatives, etc. We are based in different regions of the world. Angloville has offices in various countries in Central Europe and Asia: Kielce in Poland, Prague in Czechia, Bucharest in Romania, Budapest in Hungary, Manila in the Philippines and Cork, in Ireland.

Each year, we run hundreds of programmes in Europe and we welcome 8000+ local participants and 4000+ mentors coming from the entire English speaking world.

The Angloville experience is a two-way street: It can also benefit you.



GREECE



Therefore, at Angloville Junior, our participants can easily overcome the fear of speaking and gain fluency and confidence in English while also improving their vocabulary and comprehension.





WHO ARE THE FELLOW ENGLISH MENTORS?

OUR MENTORS

Our English-speaking Mentors are either university students or recent graduates (aged 18-35) or other enthusiastic professionals or teachers (over 35). They like to travel, explore new places and cultures, and help others.

The various speaking sessions and other activities will give you a chance to get to know and make friends with our local participants and your fellow Mentors alike. Many of our Mentors on Adult programmes still keep in touch with their mentees even years after the programme, and sometimes even visit each other later.

OUR PARTICIPANTS

Kids & Junior

Our teenage participants are primary and secondary school students, many of them have never had a chance to speak English with native speakers but want to gain confidence and fluency. Some are already planning their university studies abroad.

Adult

Our adult students come from various walks of life, from individual entrepreneurs to corporate professionals and even artists. They are successful in their profession but need a boost in their English skills, especially when it comes to communication. You can learn a lot about them, their profession, and the country itself during deep and meaningful conversations throughout the day.

AM I CAPABLE OF TEACHING ENGLISH?

MENTORING IS FOR EVERYONE

Yes, you are capable of teaching English. Having teaching experience is not a must at Angloville because we opt for an innovative method: no books, no classroom, just laid back and natural conversations over a coffee or during a walk. The idea of the programme is to create a safe environment where everyone speaks, or tries to speak, English all the time.

We ask our mentors to be personable and to have passion for sharing ideas while having conversations. When you have a simple chat, you don't have to deliver a lesson. There are no lesson plans at Angloville, you will not stand in front of the group like in a traditional teaching classroom: our programme is all about 1:1 or 2:1 conversations, like friends would have.

If you worry about not having teaching experience and you are not sure if you actually can teach at the Angloville programmes, you will have a chance to learn about the basic teaching techniques during the online Angloville Know-How training prepared for the mentors. We gathered all the best practices and teaching tips in a one-hour video.



ANGLOTEFL SCHOLARSHIP

AngloTEFL is an opportunity to become a teacher of English as a second language. Our scholarship will provide you with an online course, where you will learn about various teaching techniques as well as the practical part, during the Angloville programmes. On completion of the course and the programmes, you will receive a TEFL certificate and be ready to teach English online, give private lessons or teach in a classroom in a school.

Angloville offers you this opportunity in cooperation with Premier TEFL and sponsors up to 70% of the total cost of the scholarship. For example, if you join us for 3 weeks and complete 3 programmes, we will cover most of the scholarship fee: you will initially pay 149 EUR of which 99 EUR will be held as a deposit. Once you've completed your programmes and your certification, Angloville will refund you 99 EUR. So the final cost of the AngloTEFL certification is only 50 EUR. The best deal on the market!

ANGLOVILLE PROGRAMMES



The Angloville Kids programmes are excellent for students or recent graduates who already have some experience working with children aged 7–11. On the Kids programmes, NS mentors will be working with bilingual local teachers and groups of 4–8 students.

The Angloville Junior programmes are perfect for university students or recent graduates who would like to share their university experience and support ambitious youth in their journey to higher education in English-speaking countries. On the Junior programmes, NS mentors will be working with ambitious youth aged 12–18 (2-on-1 sessions).

Favourite destinations: Poznan, Krakow, Brno and Budapest



The Angloville Adult programme is a great opportunity for native English speakers to help local participants improve their English language skills, learn about culture and to meet likeminded travellers from around the world. On each programme there are around 12–20 local participants and an equal number of English–speaking Mentors. NS mentors will be working with adult students aged 30+ in 1-on-1 sessions and 2-on-1 sessions.

The Angloville Extended Adult programme is the longer, 9-day version of the Angloville Adult programme where you work with business professionals. On this programme, NS mentors will work in the 1-on-1 sessions and 2-on-1 sessions.

Favourite destinations: Bucharest, Warsaw, Prague and Budapest



The Angloville International programmes, like the Junior programmes, are perfect for international profiles, university students or recent graduates who would like to share their international experience and support ambitious youth in their journey to travel, live and access higher education in English-speaking countries.

On these programmes, NS mentors will be working with ambitious youth aged 12–18 (2–on–1 sessions).

DOCUMENTATION

The Angloville recruitment process is quick and straightforward: after we receive your full application on www.angloville.com, one of our advisors will call you back for a 15-minute phone interview. At the end of the interview you will know if your application has been approved and you will be offered a selection of programmes suitable for your profile and professional background.

The next steps are:

- Pay the commitment deposit (refundable)
- Provide a clear criminal record check
- Provide a letter of reference
- Provide a copy of your ID or passport
- Confirm your itinerary and travel details (bus, train or plane tickets)

SECURITY DEPOSIT

In order to book your spot, Angloville will ask you to transfer us a refundable 129 EUR deposit. Don't worry, this is just a security deposit. Once you have successfully completed our programme, Angloville will refund you 99 EUR (30 EUR go to admin, tourism & eco-tax and banking fees).

The deposit is a mandatory requirement to participate in our programme. It is also a way of showing your commitment as we are booking a spot for you and covering the cost of your accommodation, meals and local transportation.



THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT VOLUNTEERING

FLIGHTS, TRANSPORTATION TICKETS & ACCOMMODATION

Angloville recommends arriving at least one day before the start of the programme to find your way in the country and the departure city.

Arriving a day earlier will also give you a chance to attend the free city tour.

Nights before and after the programme are not included in the Angloville package. Similarly, we advise you to book your return ticket the day after the programme ends. It would be a chance to get some rest before flying back home and spend a final evening with your fellow mentors.

Angloville requires you to provide us with a copy of your itinerary and travel details 21 days after your application has been approved and your spots have been firmly booked.

INSURANCES

TRAVEL. Travel insurance should cover medical expenses, trip cancellation, lost luggage, flight incidents and other losses incurred while travelling abroad. It can generally be arranged at the time of booking your trip. Some credit card issuers offer automatic travel insurance if travel arrangements are paid for using their credit cards. There are many travel insurance policies available on the market.

HEALTH. We strongly recommend that you purchase health insurance when you travel abroad. Before volunteering with Angloville, make sure you are in sufficient physical and mental health and/or do not have any physical or mental conditions which could affect your ability to participate. You should have medical insurance coverage appropriate for your trip, your activities (included in the participation in our programme) and your medical needs.



TRAINING

KNOW-HOW, our online training for mentors

Angloville is aware of how important it is to be well-prepared and we want to offer you the best experience ever. Once your application is completed, we will provide you with online training to prepare you for our programmes. During your stay you will receive guidance from your coordinator.

If you would like to receive additional teaching training we would recommend the AngloTEFL Scholarship. The 120-hour online course can help you gain some new skills and build your confidence on the programmes.
